APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT ABSTRACT MADE

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, G. F. Hall (Name of Applicant) Union (Postoffice) County of Union State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Catherine Creek (Name of stream)

tributary of Grande Ronde River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is Three & one-half cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located at a point on the north bank of Catherine Creek (Give distance and bearing to section corner) 992 feet north and 139 feet east of the southwest corner of southeast quarter of Section 13 Tp 4 South of Range

being within the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 4 S, R. 39 E, W. M., in the county of Union (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

5. The ditch to be about .85 miles in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 4 S, R. 39 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is The Hempe-Wright-Hutchinson Irrigation Ditch

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

Hall, and consent that he may become a joint owner in said ditch by doing the work necessary on said ditch to carry the water so appropriated by him and hereafter bear his portion of expense of maintaining said ditch.
