APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Peter S. Rice, (Name of Applicant) of Mapleton, (Postoffice) County of Lane State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to

one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Park

Creek for irrigation and the development of 2 horsepower, and the right acquired by this appropriation for power development shall be, is deemed to be and is hereby expressly made subsequent in right and time to any appropriations of water which may hereafter be made at points above on Park Creek and its tributaries for irrigation and other purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 1.06 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is December 22, 1921

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 2, 1923 and shall

thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
