PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 4.9 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF
245.4 ACRES

MAXIMUM VOLUME ALLOWED: 167.1 ACRE-FEET PER YEAR

PERIOD OF USE: **MARCH 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31** FOR IRRIGATION OF 4.9 ACRES
AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 0.9 ACRES IN THE SE 1/4 NE 1/4; AND **MAY
1 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30** FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF THE REMAINING
244.5 ACRES; AND **MARCH 1 THROUGH APRIL 30 AND OCTOBER 1 THROUGH OCTOBER
31** FOR IRRIGATION OF 244.5 ACRES

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 14, 1997

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 16, T1S, R3W, W.M.;
1100 FEET NORTH AND 1960 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with
the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is
limited to 2.5 acre-feet acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the
irrigation season of each year.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order, shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month and shall submit a report which includes the recorded water use measurements to the Department annually or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

If the riparian area is disturbed in the process of developing a point of diversion, the permittee shall be responsible for restoration and enhancement of such riparian area.

The use may be restricted if the quality of the source stream or downstream water decrease to the point that those waters no longer meet state or federal water quality standards due to reduced flows.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.


By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Actual construction of the well shall begin within one year from permit issuance. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2002.
