The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

APPLICATION FILE NUMBER: S-83785

SOURCE OF WATER: NORTHRUP CREEK, RAIN RUNOFF, AND WATER FROM A GREY WATER SYSTEM, TRIBUTARIES OF NEHALEM RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD AND IRRIGATION OF LAWN OR NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE IN AREA

MAXIMUM RATE ALLOWED: 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

PERIOD OF USE: YEAR ROUND

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 16, 1998

POINT OF DIVERSION LOCATION: SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 21, T6N, R6W, W.M.; 60 FEET SOUTH AND 1310 FEET WEST FROM NE 1/16TH CORNER OF SECTION 21

THE PLACE OF USE IS LOCATED AS FOLLOWS:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information,

the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

Low flow shower heads, bathroom and kitchen faucets, and toilets shall be installed in the house prior to use of water.

A grey water system for use in toilets will be used in summer months.

A 5000 gallon tank shall be installed to provide a water source during the critical summer weeks.

All outside watering shall be done from the grey water system or water that has been collected from rain runoff from impervious surfaces.

The permittee shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening and by-pass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion. The required screen is to be in place and functional prior to diversion of any water.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

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Actual construction work shall begin by November ___, 1999. Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2003. Within one year after complete application of water to the proposed use, the permittee shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner (CWRE).
