APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 5323

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Thore A. Bakker (Name of Applicant) Wallowa (Postoffice) Wallowa County of Oregon State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Whiskey Creek (Name of stream)

tributary of Wallowa River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .5 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located For Ditch No. 1, 200 feet west of the North East Corner of the Northwest quarter of the South East quarter of Section 7. (Give distance and bearing to section corner) For Ditch No. 2, 40 rods west and 40 rods north of the NorthEast corner of the Northwest quarter of the SouthEast quarter of Section Seven.

being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 and the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 7, Tp. 1 N (No. N. or S.)

R. 43 E, W. M., in the county of Wallowa ditch

5. The ditch to be three-fourths miles

in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 18, Tp. 1 (No. N. or S.)

R. 43 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Bakke Ditch No. 1 - Bakke Ditch No. 2.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

7. (a) Height of dam 2 feet, length on top 24 feet, length at bottom 24 feet; material to be used and character of construction

Timber (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate Timber, each head gate to be 2 feet wide. (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

CANAL SYSTEM—

8. (a) Give dimensions at each point of canal where materially changed in size, stating miles from headgate. At headgate: Width on top (at water line) 5 feet; width on bottom 2 feet; depth of water 1 feet; grade 1/2 in. = feet fall per one thousand feet = rod. About the same.

(b) At miles from headgate. Width on top (at water line) feet; width on bottom feet; depth of water feet; grade feet fall per one thousand feet.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Whiskey Creek for irrigation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is May 29, 1922

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1923 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1924

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1925
