This superseding permit is issued to describe an amendment for a change in place of use proposed under Water Right Transfer Application T-12699 and approved by Special Order Vol. 113, Page 123, entered May 16, 2019, and to describe an extension of time for complete application of water approved October 26, 2018. This permit supersedes Permit S-49958.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.


Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit, when issued, is for the beneficial use of water.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

The original permit was issued May 27, 1987. Complete application of the water to the use was to be made on or before October 1, 1990. By Extension of Time Final Order dated October 26, 2018, the deadline for complete application of water to use was extended to October 1, 2023. Within one year after complete application of water to the proposed use, the permittee shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner (CWRE).
