APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Cameron Squires, of Portland, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is All Springs (Name of stream)

tributary of Willamette Watershed

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.29 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic supplies and Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located on Lots 122, 123, 124, 125, 126 and 127 of Dunthorpe, otherwise known as 880 ft. northerly from corner of Sections 34 & 35 T 1 S R 1 E and Sections 2 & 3 T 2 S R 1 E.W.M.

being within the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 1 South, R. 1 East, W. M., in the county of Multnomah (No. N. or S.)

5. The ditch to be 250 yards approximately in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 1 S, R. 1 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from springs for domestic and irrigation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.19 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is August 12, 1922

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 8, 1923, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1924

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1925
