ABSTRACT MADE

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, S. L. Banks (Name of Applicant) of Hood River, Ore., R.D. #3, County of Hood River, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Springs, the water of which sinks in the ground just below springs tributary of Indian Cr.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.025 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 701 feet East and 1012 North of the 1/4 Section corner between Sections 8 and 17, Twp. 2 N and R. 10 East W.M.

being within the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 8, Tp. 2 N, R. 10 E, W. M., in the county of Hood River

5. The pipe line to be 3500 feet in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 8, Tp. 2 N, R. 10 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Banks' Pipe Line.

STATE OF OREGON,) ss. County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from unnamed springs for domestic use.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is January 22, 1923.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 31, 1924. and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1925

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1926.
