# To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Charles E. Hutchanson,  
 (Name of Applicant)  
 of North Powder, County of Union,  
 (Postoffice)  
Oregon, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Wolf Creek  
 (Name of stream)  
 tributary of North Powder River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is  
.79 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation  
 (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located

being within the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 6 S  
 (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)  
R. 39 E, W. M., in the county of Union  
 (No. E. or W.)

5. The Main ditch now constructed 3.5 miles  
 (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Sunnyslope Ditch)  
 in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 2, Tp. 6 S  
 (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)  
R. 39 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.  
 (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Sunnyslope Ditch

## DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

### DIVERSION WORKS—

7. (a) Height of dam 2 feet, length on top 18 feet, length at bottom 18 feet; material to be used and character of construction Timber crib.  
 (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate Concrete.  
 (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

CANAL SYSTEM—

8. (a) Give dimensions at each point of canal where materially changed in size, stating miles from headgate. At headgate: Width on top (at water line) 8.0 feet; width on bottom 6.0 feet; depth of water 2.0 feet; grade 1 3/4" feet fall per one thousand feet.

(b) At 3 miles from headgate. Width on top (at water line) 6.0 feet; width on bottom 4.0 feet; depth of water 1.0 feet; grade 2 feet fall per one thousand feet.

*This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.*

*The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Wolf Creek for irrigation purposes.*

*The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.79 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is August 2, 1923.*

*Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 31, 1924 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1925*

*Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1926.*
