APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, L. Klinefelter (Name of Applicant) of North Powder (Postoffice), County of Union, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Anthony Creek (Name of stream)

tributary of North Powder River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.75 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located about the center of the SE of NW and the NW SE of Section 20 Township 6 S Range 38 E.W.M. (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the Northwest SE and SE NW of Sec. 20, Tp. 6 S (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 38 E, W. M., in the county of Baker and Union Co. (No. E. or W.)

5. The ditch to be 1/4 miles in length, terminating in the NW SE of Sec. 20, Tp. 6 S (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 38 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Klinefelter Ditch.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Anthony Creek for irrigation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.35 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is November 26, 1923.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 19, 1925. and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1926.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1927
