APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Mrs. Albert Boesch, of Pilot Rock, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is McKay Creek (Name of stream)

tributary of Umatilla River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.27 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located N 462 ft. & East 100 ft. one diversion and South 594 ft. East 792 ft. both from the NW corner of Sec. 1 Tp. 1 S. R. 32 E.W.M.

being within the SE 1/4, SE 1/4, NW 1/4, NW 1/4 of Sec. 1, Tp. 1 S, R. 32 E, W. M., in the county of Umatilla total

5. The Isabella & Hornton Ditches are about 2 miles in length, terminating in the SW NE & NE 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 1 N, R. 32 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Isabella & Hornton Ditches.

to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject
to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.*

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from

McKay Creek for irrigation purposes.
