APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Chas. S. Dykstra, (Name of Applicant) Oregon City, Ore. R.D.6 (Postoffice), County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the

following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed spring (Name of stream)

tributary of Polcomb Creek (Willamette Watershed)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/40 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic and Irrigation. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 786 feet west and 20 feet north of the 1/4 section corner on the east line of Section 27 T 2 S R 2 E of W. 11: (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 27, Tp. 2 S, R. 2 E, W. M., in the county of Clackamas (No. N. or S.)

5. The ditch to be at beginning point of miles spring and irrigate from that point 2 acres in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 27, Tp. 2 S, R. 2 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Nil.

STATE OF OREGON,) ss. County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from an unnamed spring for domestic and irrigation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is February 25, 1924.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 22, 1925. and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1926

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1927
