APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, ANDREW PARKER, of Vernonia, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is An unnamed branch (Name of stream)

tributary of Nehalem River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is one-half cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic supplies (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located N 76°35' E 2560 feet from the 1/2 section corner between Sections 3 and 4, T 4 N R 4 W. of W.M. (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. three, Tp. four North, R. Four West, W. M., in the county of Columbia (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

5. The pipe line to be 1730 feet miles in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. three, Tp. Four North, R. Four West, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Andrew Parker's Water System.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

7. (a) Height of dam twelve feet, length on top eighteen feet, length at bottom five feet; material to be used and character of construction Concrete with wasteway over dam. (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from an unnamed branch of Nehalem River for domestic supply.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is April 8, 1924.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 22, 1925 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1926.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1927
