APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 7069

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, L. M. Mitchell, (Name of Applicant) of Murphy (Postoffice), County of Josephine, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation Not incorporated.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Springs, (Name of stream) tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.05 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation and domestic. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 16, (Give distance and bearing to section corner) thence East 80 rods, thence south 1645 feet; thence east 525 feet.

being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 36 S (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 5 W, W. M., in the county of Josephine (No. E. or W.)

5. The Pipe Line (1 inch pipe) to be 1385 feet (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) miles in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 36 S (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 5 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Hyde Pipe Line, by means of which water is conducted from said Spring to house, and used for domestic supply at house and for irrigation of lawns and gardens.

Remarks: The springs described in this application are located at the edge of the county road described in the dedication of Tokay Heights in accordance with the plats filed in the office of the County Assessor for Josephine County. The appropriation above applied for has been completely perfected and completed and water applied to beneficial use as above applied for, under and by virtue of Application No. 7178, Permit No. 4516, filed by Ella T. Hyde, but by reason of failure to file proof of completion and other proofs said Permit No. 4516 was cancelled by the State Engineer. The works described above were completed and water used by applicant's predecessors within the time fixed in said Permit No. 4516 and this application is for the purpose of securing and perfecting the said appropriation and as a basis for the issuance of a water right Certificate to applicant. Applicant is the successor in interest in ownership of the above described lands and works to said Ella T. Hyde, and herewith requests the issuance of water right Certificate to him. Map filed with said Permit 4516 is hereby referred to as a part of this application. Said map will be re-filed if required.

STATE OF OREGON,) ss. County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Springs in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 16 T 36 S R 5 W.W.M. for irrigation and domestic purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is October 6, 1924.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 28, 1925. and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1926.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1927
