APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 7627

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, H. D. Ledford (Name of applicant) of Forest Grove, R. 1 (Postoffice), County of Washington, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from a spring branch for domestic purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is June 8, 1925.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 26, 1926 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1927 extended to 6/1/28

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1928
