APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 6782

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, F. P. McCurdy, (Name of applicant) of Scottsburg, (Postoffice), County of Douglas, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is An unnamed creek (Name of stream), tributary of Umpqua River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 2/10 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located S. 10° E. 300 ft. from the SW cor. of Lot 1, Sec. 24 (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 24, Tp. 22 S, R. 10 W, Douglas (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

5. The pipe line to be 500 feet (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) miles in length, terminating in the Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) of Sec. 24, Tp. 22 S, R. 10 W, Douglas (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is McCurdy Ranch System.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

7. (a) Height of dam 1 ft. feet, length on top 5 feet, length at bottom 3 feet; material to be used and character of construction Loose rock, wasteway over. (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate Intake tank 3' X 3' X 8 ft. Wood - located near intake dam. (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from an unnamed stream for domestic purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.2 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is October 20, 1925.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 26, 1926 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1927

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1928
