APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, W. R. Anderson and Genett Anderson of Wonder Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Butcherknife Creek, tributary of Slate Cr. to Applegate River,

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.1 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic (Service Sta. and auto Park.)

4. The point of diversion is located

being within the NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 37 S, R. 7 W, W. M., in the county of Josephine

5. The ditch to be 1/2 miles in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 37 S, R. 7 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Love Sta. Ditch.

STATE OF OREGON, County of Marion, ss.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Butcherknife Creek for domestic purposes including supply for auto park and service station.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is November 7, 1925.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 18, 1926. and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1927

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1928
