APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 9768

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, J. W. Tracy, (Name of applicant) Canyon City, (Postoffice) Grant, County of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Tracy Creek and Goss Creek (Name of stream) tributary of Canyon Creek - John Day River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1 sec. ft. cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Placer Mining. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located N. 45 W- 1000 feet from East 1/4 cor. Sec. 9. Pt. of diversion for Tracy Cr. and N. 26 W-400 ft. from South 1/4 cor Sec. 9 for Goss Cr. diversion, all in T 14 S. R. 31 E.W.M.

being within the SE NE and SE SW of Sec. 9, Tp. 14 S. R. 31 E., W. M., in the county of Grant (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

5. The main ditch to mines to be 2.5 miles in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 13 S. R. 31 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Tracy Ditch

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited

to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Tracy Creek and Goss Creek for placer mining purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is February 20, 1925.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 2, 1927 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1928

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1929 Extended to Oct. 1, 1932
