

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

APPROPRIATION

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, J. W. Stringer (Name of applicant) of Grants Pass, Route 4 (Postoffice), County of Josephine, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Rogue River (Name of stream), tributary of Pacific Ocean

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.25 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 20, Tp. 36 S, R. 6 W, W. M., in the county of Josephine (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

5. The ditch to be 1/2 miles in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 20, Tp. 36 S, R. 6 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Stringer Ditch

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS— Pump from River. Lift 15 feet.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Rogue River for irrigation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is January 22, 1926

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 23, 1927 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1928

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1929
