

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, J. W. Hamilton, (Name of applicant)
of John Day, (Postoffice), County of Grant,
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Canyon Creek (Name of stream), tributary of John Day River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.04 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located South 60 degrees East, 1519 feet from corner (Give distance and bearing to section corner) common to Secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27, Township 13 South, Range 31 East W.M.

being within the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 26, Tp. 13 South, R. 31 East, W. M., in the county of Grant (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

5. The ditch to be 0.25 miles in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 23, Tp. 13 South, R. 31 East, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is White Ditch

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

7. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom

feet; material to be used and character of construction
Diversion works of said ditch at present are described as follows: A wing of brush and rock and earth, height 3 ft., length on top 15 feet, bottom 20 feet. (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

Spillway around dam. It is proposed to extend the present wing 5 feet further. No changes in height or character of material.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited

to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Canyon Creek for irrigation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of

rotation. The priority date of this permit is January 25, 1926. February 10, 1927

Actual construction work shall begin on or before and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1928

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1929
