APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 6790

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, The First Congregation Church of Forest Grove, Oregon, (Name of applicant) of Forest Grove (Postoffice), County of Washington, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation May 6th, 1882, at Forest Grove, Ore.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Gales Creek (Name of stream), tributary of Tualatin River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is Nine-Eighths (.112) cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, minings, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located approximately 1360 feet East and 600 feet South of the Northwest corner of Sect. 1 T. 1 S. Range 3 W.W.M. (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the NE 40 of NW 1/4 of Sec. One, Tp. One S, R. Three W, W. M., in the county of Washington (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

5. The pipe line to be 1000 feet. (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) miles in length, terminating in the SE 40 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 36, Tp. 1 N, R. 3 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Pipe Line of Forest View Cemetery

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Gales Creek for irrigation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.12 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is February 27, 1926.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 10, 1927 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1928

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1929
