APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

ABSTRACT MADE

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, A. H. Shafer, (Name of applicant) Enterprise (Postoffice), County of Wallows, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Hurricane Creek (Name of stream), tributary of Wallows River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.19 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Supplemental Irrigation. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located No survey. (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 2 South, R. 44 East, W. M., in the county of Wallows canal to be three (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited including water heretofore appropriated to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Hurricane Creek for irrigation of lands already having a partial water right.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.19 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is March 15, 1926.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 22, 1927 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1928

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1929
