APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, O. R. Gullion (Name of applicant) Eugene, Lane County of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Simmonds Creek (Name of stream), tributary of Blue River (McKenzie River)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 2 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Power for generating electricity, supply ing fish pond and pools and artificial brook, In general for the purpose of developing and beautifying grounds for a mountain home.

4. The point of diversion is located 3000 feet from SW corner of Section 21 in northeasterly direction. (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 21, Tp. 16 S, R. 4 E, W. M., in the county of Lane (No. E. or W.) (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

5. The main canal to be 700 feet / ft/qs in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 21, Tp. 16 S, R. 4 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Not named.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Simmonds Creek for development of 3.6 theoretical horsepower, and for fish ponds and pools, including the use of water for beautifying grounds.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is May 6, 1926.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 20, 1927 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1928

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1929
