CERTIFICATE NO. 7282

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Oswego Lake Water, Light & Power Company, of 205 Porter Bldg., Portland, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation Portland, Oregon January, 1915

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Bryant Spring, tributary of Oswego Lake (Tualatin River)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is one cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic and garden Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located South 30* 08' West 704 ft. from common Section corner of Sections 7, 8, 17, 18 T. 2 S. R. 1 E

being within the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 18, Tp. 2 S, R. 1 E, W. M., in the county of Clackamas pipelines to be twelve

5. The (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) miles in length, terminating in the Sections 7, 8, 17, 18 of Sec. 18, Tp. 2 S, R. 1 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Bryant Spring

Remarks: This is a Spring from which water has been pumped for three or four years as an auxiliary in the summer time to the regular water supply for the residents in the westerly end of Oswego Lake and is used by them for domestic use and irrigation of gardens. This spring is pumped into a system of 55,200 ft. of 1", 2", 4" pipe.

This application is made without prejudice to any riparian rights which The Oswego Lake Water, Light and Power Company may have as owners of the real property through which the water flows for which a permit is applied for in this application.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited

to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Bryant Spring for domestic purposes, including garden irrigation.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is May 17, 1926.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 28, 1927 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1928

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1929
