To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, HERMAN HUKARI (Name of applicant) of Hood River (Postoffice), County of Hood River State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

- 1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed stream (Name of stream), tributary of Indian Creek
2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 4 minars 1 inches cubic feet per second.
3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic use and supplementary irrigation.
4. The point of diversion is located 40 chains west and 13 North of the corner common to sections 9, 10, 15 and 16 in T. 2 N. R. 10 E., and located on applicants property

being within the W 1/2 SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 9, Tp. 2 N. R. 10 E., W. M., in the county of Hood River

- 5. The Pipe line to be 1250 ft. miles in length, terminating in the W 1/2 SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 9, Tp. 2 N. R. 10 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited

to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from

an unnamed spring, tributary of Indian Creek for domestic use and supplementary irrigation.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed .25 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is August 2, 1926

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 17, 1927 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1928

EXTENDED TO 6/129

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1929
