APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 7107

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

We, D. T. Werschul, Mary M. Jenck & Sons, Elma Johnson and Lizzie Scott of Cloverdale, County of Tillamook, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed branch, tributary of Clear Creek (Nestucca River).

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .05 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic supply (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 440' S. and 390' E. of NW corner of SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 34, Tp. 4 S., R. 10 West.

being within the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 34, Tp. 4 S., R. 10 W., W. M., in the county of Tillamook.

5. The pipe lines to be approx. 1.5 (1 5/8) miles in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 28 of Sec. 27-28, Tp. 4 S., R. 10 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from an Unnamed Branch of Clear Creek for domestic purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is September 14, 1926.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 8, 1927 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1928

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1929
