

# To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, W. W. Cameron (Name of applicant)  
 of Jacksonville, County of Jackson,  
 State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the  
 following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is 2 springs tributary of Big Applegate  
 River, tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is  
 No. 1 0.05, No. 2 0.05 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic use and irrigation of garden  
 and lawns around house.

4. The point of diversion is located No. 1 spring East 575 feet and South 750 feet  
 from 1/4 corner between Sec. 15 and 17 1/2

No. 2 Spring North 458 feet and East 300 feet  
 from Center Sec. 15, both springs being in Sec. 15, T. 39 S. R. 3 W. W. M.

being within the No. 1 NW 1/4 SW 1/4, No. 2 SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 39 S  
R. 3 W, W. M., in the county of Jackson

5. The No. 1 Pipe 900 feet; No. 2 Pipe 300 feet to be 1260 feet  
 miles in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 & SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 15, Tp. 39 S

R. 3 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Two Springs, tributary to Big Applegate River, for irrigation and domestic purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is December 6, 1926.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 20, 1927 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

June 1, 1928 EXTENDED TO 6/1/29

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1929
