APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 8025

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, J. E. Nichols (Name of applicant) of Glendale (Postoffice), County of Douglas, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is known as the schoolhouse spring (Name of stream), tributary of Cow Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/100th cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 870 ft. west and 85 ft. north of northwest corner of southeast 1/4 of south east 4 of Sec. 19. (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 32 south, R. 5 west, W. M., in the county of Douglas (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.)

5. The pipe line 3/4 inch galvanized to be 2350 ft. (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) miles in length, terminating in the NW Cor. of SW 1/4 of south 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 32 south, R. 5 W. (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.) (No. E. or W.), W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Nichols Pipe line

*This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,
subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited
to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject
to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.*

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from School-
house Spring for domestic purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to bene-
ficial use and not to exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of
rotation. The priority date of this permit is January 19, 1927

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 12, 1928 and shall
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
June 1, 1929

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before
October 1, 1930
