APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Oregon State Game Commission (Name of applicant) of Portland (Postoffice), County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Short Creek & Silent Creek (Name of stream), tributary of Diamond Lake, trib. N. Umpqua River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is from Short Creek and 15 second feet from Silent Creek 10 sec. ft. cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Fish propagation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located near the center of NW NE of Section 17, (The entire Creek is within this 40 acres). (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

The diversion on Silent Creek is about the center of SE NW of Section 19.

being within the (1) NW NE Sec. 17 (2) SE NW Sec. 19 of Sec. (Give smallest legal subdivision), Tp. 28 S. (No. N. or S.)

5. The racks and hatching troughs on Short Creek flume & pipes on Silent Creek (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be about 1/4

miles in length, terminating in the (1) NW NE (2) SE NW of Sec. (1) 17 (2) 19, Tp. 28 S. (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

R. 6 E. (No. E. or W.), W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Oregon State Game Commission

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Short and Silent Creeks for fish propagation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 10.0 cubic feet per second, from Short Creek and 15.0 " " " " from Silent Creek. rotation. The priority date of this permit is October 14, 1926

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 28, 1928 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1929

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1930
