APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 7292

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Maurice Moore (Name of applicant) of Walton (Postoffice), County of Lane, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Walker Creek (Name of stream), tributary of Siuslaw River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1/10 of one cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1350 feet from the south west corner of Section One. Bearing from sec. corner N. 56° E.

being within the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. One, Tp. 18 S., R. 8 W., W. M., in the county of Lane

5. The main ditch to be 1/5 of one mile in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. One, Tp. 18 S., R. 8 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Moore Irrigation ditch.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Walker Creek for irrigation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.13 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is February 16, 1927.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 4, 1928 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1929

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1930.
