To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, E. C. Parmale (Name of applicant) of Taft (Postoffice), County of Lincoln, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 35, T. 7 S., R. 11 W., (Drift River), tributary of

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.1 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located One half mile North of a Surveyors stake, which is 1330 ft. East of Section corner common to Sec. 35 and 34, T. 7 S. R. 11 W. and Sections 2 and 3 T. 8 S. R. 11 W. W. M.

being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 7 S., R. 11 W., W. M., in the county of Lincoln

5. The 2" Pipe line (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) to be one half miles in length, terminating in the South 40 of 80 of Sec. 35, Tp. 7 S., R. 11 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from a Spring in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Sec. 35, T. 7 S., R. 11 W. W. W., for domestic purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is February 25, 1927.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 15, 1928, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1929

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1930
