APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Southern Pacific Co., by Jas. A. Lathrop (Name of applicant) of Portland (Postoffice), County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Crank (Name of stream), tributary of Siuslaw River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .05 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Railroad domestic use for section ctrs. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of division is located 4367.47' S. 57° 32' 30" E. of NW Corner Sec. 18 (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 18, Tp. 18 S., R. 8 W., W. M., in the county of Lane (Give smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

5. The 2" pipe line (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be .25 miles in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Sec. 18, Tp. 18 S., R. 8 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (No. N. or S.)

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Richardson domestic supply

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from An Unnamed Creek, tributary of Siuslaw River, for railroad domestic use for section quarters.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is August 19, 1927

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 1, 1928 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1929

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1930
