APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 7597

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Carl B. Neal, Forest Supervisor, U.S. Department of Agriculture of Roseburg, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is North Umpqua River, tributary of Umpqua River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.10 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of division is located S. 32° W. 17 chains from the corner between Secs. 18 and 19, T. 26 S., R. 3 W., W.M. and S. 9° 30' W. 14.8 chains from the NW corner of D.L.C. 5. The pipe line to be 400 ft in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 19, Tp. 26 S., R. 3 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Glide Ranger Station pipe line.

*This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,
subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited
to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject
to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.*

~~The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water
from North Umpqua River for domestic purposes.~~

*The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to bene-
ficial use and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of
rotation. The priority date of this permit is January 17, 1928*

*Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 31, 1929 and shall
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1930
October 1, 1931*
