APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 8647

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, A. P. Smith, 605 S. Newtown Street (Name of applicant) of Medford (Postoffice), County of Jackson, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is spring, tributary of South Fork of Emigrant Creek, tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.25 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is additional supply to Hobart Lake for propagation of fur bearing animals

4. The point of division is located N. 20° W. 1150 ft. from 1/4 corner between Sections 16 and 17, T. 40 S., R. 3 E., W.M. Location of spring being 460 feet North and 260 feet West of above named 1/4 corner. Springs and diversion

being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 17, Tp. 40 S., R. 3 E., W. M., in the county of Jackson

5. The pipe line to be 1/4 miles in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 16, Tp. 40 S., R. 3 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is A. P. Davis Pipe Line

STATE OF OREGON, County of Marion, ss.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from an Unnamed Spring for additional supply to Hobart Lake for propagation of fur bearing animals.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is June 17, 1927

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 28, 1929 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1930

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1931
