APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 9503

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, W.H. Divers (Name of applicant) of Baker (Postoffice), County of Baker, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Waste water from McCord Ditch (Name of stream), tributary of Powder River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of division is located Approximately 438 ft. north and 400 ft. east of SW corner NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 20, being at intersection of 16th and Estes Streets in City of Baker.

being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 20, Tp. 9 S, R. 40 E, W. M., in the county of Baker

5. The Main ditch to be 538 feet miles in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 20, Tp. 9 S, R. 40 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

*This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited  
to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject  
to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.*

*The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of waste  
water from the McCord ditch, tributary of Powder River for irrigation  
purposes.*

*The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to bene-  
ficial use and not to exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of  
rotation. The priority date of this permit is July 23, 1928*

*Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 6, 1929 and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before  
June 1, 1930*

*Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before  
October 1, 1931*
