APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, C. R. Miller (Name of applicant) of Portland (234 Flanders St.) (Postoffice), County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Fern Creek (Name of stream), tributary of Zig Zag Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .80 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic S upplies (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of division is located S. 71° E, 290 feet, thence S. 34 30' E 1500 feet (Give distance and bearing to section corner) to 1/4 corner on east boundary of Sec. 13, T. 3 S., R. 7. E., W.M.

in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 3 S., R. 7 E., W.M. being within the Zig Zag Ski Club (Give smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. Mt. Hood National Forest (No. N. or S.), R. Clackamas (No. E. or W.), W. M., in the county of

5. The Pipe (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 600 ft. miles in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. indicated above (No. N. or S.), R. W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is no name

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

7. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate The head gate consists of a 10 gallon keg which is used largely as a settling chamber. A 6 inch pipe leads from this keg to our storage which in turn consists of 3-500 gal. portable wood-stave tanks located on the bank 20 ft. from the creek channel and 15 ft. above high water marks. Fall from intake to place of use, approx. 90 ft.

A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated. These forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

11. To supply ~~the~~ several summer homes located on the Ski Club tract above described County, having a present population of fluctuating from 2 to 30 persons and an estimated population of no increase in population anticipated.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Fern Creek for domestic purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is August 16, 1928

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 8, 1929 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1930

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1931
