To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

Ic We, Diamond Lake Improvement Co. (Name of applicant) of Medford (Postoffice), County of Jackson, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation June 7, 1922, Medford, Oregon.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Springs No. 1 and 2, Tributary to Two Bear Creek, tributary of Diamond Lake

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.1 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic and camp purposes (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of division is located Spring No. 1 piped to Spring No. 2 located S. 43° E. 1520 feet from 1/4 corner between sections 29 and 32, Twp. 27 S., R. 6 E., W.M.

being within the Both springs within of Sec. 32, Tp. 27 S, R. 6 E., W. M., in the county of Douglas

5. The pipe line to be 2100 feet miles in length, terminating in the of Sec. 32, Tp. 27 S, R. 6 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is Diamond Lake Improvement Company pipe line

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Springs Nos. 1 and 2, tributary to Two-Bear Creek for domestic and camp purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is October 6, 1928.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 22, 1929 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1930.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1931.
