APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

I, Ralph Gilchrist, of Alpena, County of Alpena, State of Michigan, do hereby declare that I am the owner of 960 acres of land situated in Sections 18 and 19, Township 22 South, Range 10 East and Section 24, Township 22 South, Range 9 East, lying on and adjacent to the East Fork of the Deschutes River, which lands were acquired and are being held for the location of a lumber manufacturing plant and town site, to manufacture the timber from approximately 70,000 acres of land located in the Counties of Deschutes, Klamath and Lake, in the State of Oregon, which are owned by me, and the timber from which lands would be available for manufacture at the above described location on the East Fork of the Deschutes River, and I do hereby make application for permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

The source of the proposed appropriation is the East Fork of the Deschutes River.

The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use, is two cubic feet per second.

The use to which the water is to be applied, is domestic, municipal uses and fire protection.

The point of diversion is at a point on the said East Fork of the Deschutes River at or near the south line of the SW1984 of Section 34, in Township 28 South, Range 9 East, W.M. in Deschutes County, Oregon and to be conveyed through a system of pipes through and about the plant and town in the N_2 of Section 19, Township 22 South, Range 10 East.

It is intended by this appropriation to use the water for the purpose of furnishing water for domestic purposes, including municipal irrigation of lawns and gardens, for the use of a population of about 1500 people in a town to be located and established in the said No of Section 19, Twp. 22 South, Range 10 East, W.M., and it is proposed to take the water from the river by means of a system of pumps and page lines, the estimated cost thereof being \$60,000.00.
