

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Wm. D. McCullough (Name of applicant) of Corbett (Postoffice), County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is McCullough Creek, tributary of Gordon Creek, a tributary of Sandy River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.49 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic, including irrigation of garden and power

4. The point of diversion is located 400 ft. N and 600 ft. E from the SW corner of SE 1/4, Sec. 3; No. 2, 300 ft. N. and 600 ft. E. from same corner

being within the SE 1/4 of Sec. 3, Tp. 1 S, R. 5 E, W. M., in the county of Multnomah

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.49 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from McCullough Creek, tributary of Gordon Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic, including irrigation of garden and development of 2 theoretical horsepower.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 8, 1929

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 15, 1931 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before

October 1, 1932 Extended to Oct. 1, 1935 Extended to Oct. 1, 1934

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1933
