

***APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT**

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, B. D. Fidler (Name of applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the
following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

These springs arise upon my own lands and this filing is made with the intention of reserving all of my vested and riparian rights. The description of my lands is as follows: Beginning at a point 10.0 chs. N. 89°52' E. and 19.123 chs. N. 0°02' W. from the 1/4 section corner between sections 12 and 13 in T. 8 S., R. 4 W. of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County Oregon; thence N. 89°34' W. 1.21 chains to a stone; thence South 70 links to a stone; thence S. 83°28' W. 1.68 chains, to a stone; thence North 81 links, to a shot gun barrel; thence N. 89°18' W. 18.25 chains, to an iron pipe; thence North 7.50 chains; thence S. 89°59' E. 21.13 chains, to the west line of the A. D. Pettyjohn Estate; thence S. 0°02' E. 7.65 chains, to the place of beginning and containing 16.22 acres of land.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from B. D. Fidler Springs, tributary of Willamette River Watershed.

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic, including irrigation of garden.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 20, 1930

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 21, 1931 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1932

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1933
