

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, W. S. Stringer (Name of applicant) of Grants Pass, Route 3 (Postoffice), County of Josephine, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed Springs (Name of stream), a tributary of Applegate River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.05 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic with garden (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Unnamed Springs

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic use including garden irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 26, 1930

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 10, 1931 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1932 Extended to Oct. 1, 1933

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1933
