APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

I, Ida McKee (Name of Applicant)

of Woodville, County of Jackson (Postoffice)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation.

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Evans Creek (Name of stream)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is Enough water to irrigate 9 acres. Do not know what it will be in cu. ft. cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located East of the SW corner of 21 - 3/4 of a mile, thence north 80 rods, thence east 500 ft. to creek. (Give distance and bearing to section corner)

STATE OF OREGON, County of Marion. ss.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The appropriation for irrigation purposes shall be limited to one-eighth of one cu. ft. per sec. for each acre irrigated. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State officer. The priority date of this permit is November 1, 1911.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 11/100 (0.11) cubic feet per second. or its equivalent in case of rotation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 8, 1913

and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before February 8, 1914

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before February 8, 1915
