PERMIT No. 12070

To appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, MILTON CITY, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, of Milton City, county of Umatilla, state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. Give name of nearest stream to which the well, tunnel or other source of water development is situated Walla Walla River tributary of Columbia River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is approx. 1.5 cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic, industrial, commercial, & municipal.

4. The place where the water is to be pumped or developed is located on the E 40' of Lot 5, Block 7 of McCoy's Addition to Milton City.

being within the NW 1/4 Sec. 12, Twp. 5 N., R. 35 E., W. M., in the county of Umatilla

5. To be connected to existing City Water mains at a point approx. 40 ft. South and approx. 264 ft. West of location of said well, in length, terminating in the West of Sec. 12, Twp. 5 N., R. 35 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the well or other works is Milton City Well No. 1

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

7. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of the supply when not in use must be described.

8. The development will consist of one well having a diameter of 12 inches and an estimated depth of 600 feet.

- 15. Construction work will begin on or before Feb. 1, 1937
- 16. Construction work will be completed on or before May 15, 1937
- 17. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before May 15, 1937

Remarks: Your early approval of this application is urgently requested. Due to unavoidable delay in calling for bids, an emergency exists. As you are no doubt aware, further unavoidable delays may occur during the drilling operations. This Well is being drilled to supplement the present City Water Supply and to provide an absolutely clear supply of water for Pea Canning purposes, on or before May 15, 1937. The present City Water Supply is obtained from the Walla Walla River. During periods of flood, the water becomes very muddy and is unsuitable for domestic, commercial, or industrial purposes. Under an existing contract between Milton City and The P. J. Burk Canning Co., the City is obligated to supply clear water and is liable for damages should it fail to comply with the terms of the contract.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.5 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a well

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic, industrial, commercial and municipal

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 18, 1937

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 21, 1938 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1939

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1940
