REMARKS

Applicants are the owners of an Estate by the entirety of the property described as Lots number 1 and 2 of Middletown according to the recorded plat thereof in the office of the County Clerk of Union County, Oregon, said Lots 1 and 2 comprising the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, Twp. 3 S., R. 38 E., W.M., Union County, Oregon and as shown by the blue print which accompanies this application.

The well for which this filing is made is located on the west end of Lot No. 2 and about 10 rods from the northwest corner thereof and being in about the middle of the west end of Lot No. 2. This would make it approximately 50 rods south of the northwest corner of the 40 acre tract. This well has been in continuous use for many years and long before applicants purchased the property and probably since about 1905, and has been used regularly each year for the irrigation of the property. No further development is to be done at this time, nor is any further development necessary. The well is approximately 6 feet across and about 9 feet deep and fills to within about 4 feet of the top.

As far as known, there is no stream nor channel upon which said well is located, although it is located in the bottom of a slight swale, said swale has no running water nor is it swampy in any way so that it could not be considered as a slough. Also other owners situated on the same slight depression have dug for wells but have never been able to get any. The water is applied to all of the land owned by applicants, and the use of the land is orchard, berries, garden, corn, potatoes and similar farm uses and a little over an acre of irrigated pasture for a cow.

Applicants claim that said well is not on any channel nor stream as defined by the laws of Oregon, but make this filing at the request of the Federal Land Bank by reason of application for a loan being made thereon, and so as to remove any question as to the rights involved in said well. It is not artesian and its water can be used only by pumping.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from A well

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 1, 1938

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 28, 1939 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1940

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1941
