

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Frederick T. Arnold (Name of applicant) of Brogan (Postoffice), county of Malheur, state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. Give name of nearest stream to which the well, tunnel or other source of water development is situated Willow Creek (Name of stream) tributary of Malheur River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is One (1) cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation (Supplemental)

4. The place where the water is to be pumped or developed is located midway of north line of (Give distance and bearing from section corner)

being within the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 19, Twp. 15 S., R. 43 E., W. M., in the county of Malheur

5. The None (Canal or pipe line) to be miles in length, terminating in the (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. Twp. R., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the well or other works is Unnamed

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

7. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of the supply when not in use must be described.

8. The development will consist of One Well (Give number of wells, tunnels, etc.) having a diameter of 5' x 6 1/2' inches and an estimated depth of 22 feet. later to be drilled to 42'

- 15. Construction work will begin on or before at once
- 16. Construction work will be completed on or before November 1, 1939
- 17. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before November 1, 1939

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from A Well

The use to which this water is to be applied is Supplemental Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated prior to May 1, and 1/30th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the remainder of the irrigation season; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 8, 1939

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 20, 1940 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1941

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1942
