To appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, G. W. Burnet (Name of applicant)

state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate
the following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

T. 15 S. R. 16 E. W.M. exact location 15 feet West and 10 feet North

W. M., in the county of Crook

in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 5, Twp. 15 S.,

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from A Well

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 28, 1945

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 1, 1946 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1947

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1948
