

APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

# To appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Eastern Oregon Foods Co-op (Name of applicant)  
of Weston, Ore. (Postoffice), county of Umatilla,  
state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate  
the following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:**

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation Weston, Ore. Aug. 29, 1945

1. Give name of nearest stream to which the well, tunnel or other source of water development  
is situated Pine Creek (Name of stream)  
tributary of Walla Walla, River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is Two  
cubic feet per second. Bob: 1 cubic foot per second = 449 Gallons Per Minute.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Canning and freezing fruits  
and vegetables.

4. The place where the water is to be pumped or developed is located  
The well will be located close to the center of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 15,  
(Give distance and bearing from section corner)  
T. 4 N., R. 35 E. W.M.; 1400 Ft. East, 650 Ft. North of Sec. Corner 16, 15, 21, 22.  
being within the S.E. 1/4 of the S. W. 1/4 of Sec. 15, Twp. 4 N, R. 35 E,  
W. M., in the county of Umatilla

5. The (Canal or pipe line) to be miles  
in length, terminating in the (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. , Twp. ,  
R. , W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the well or other works is Eastern Oregon Foods Co-op.

## DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

7. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of  
the supply when not in use must be described.

8. The development will consist of One well having a

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from A Well

The use to which this water is to be applied is Canning and freezing fruits and vegetables.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 18, 1945

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 20, 1946 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1947

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1948
