The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceedQ.75 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the
well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from
a well

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to
second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated prior to May 1, and 1/80th of one
cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the remainder

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer
