To appropriate the Underground Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Charles C. Brooks (Name of applicant)
of Route #1, Box 72, Mosier, Oregon (Postoffice), county of Wasco,
state of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate
the following described underground waters of the state of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.4
cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation

(Give distance and bearing from section corner)

being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 7, Twp. 2 N., R. 12 E.,
W. M., in the county of Wasco

5. The pipe line (Canal or pipe line) to be 0.25 miles
in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 (Smallest legal subdivision) of Sec. 7, Twp. 2 N.,
R. 13 E., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the well or other works is Brooks Well.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

7. If the flow to be utilized is artesian, the works to be used for the control and conservation of
the supply when not in use must be described.

The flow of water is artesian, and the well is capped and a valve, installed to
control the flow.

8. The development will consist of one well (Give number of wells, tunnels, etc.) having a
diameter of 6 inches and an estimated depth of 180 feet.

The well has been drilled and it is the plan of the applicant to utilize the
unexpected flow of artesian water.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.32 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a well

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/30th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The well shall be so cased as to prevent loss of underground water.

The priority date of this permit is March 25, 1947

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 30, 1949 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1950

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1951
