This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.48 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a well

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. The well shall be so cased as to prevent loss of underground water; provided further that no surplus water shall be allowed to enter any stream. The priority date of this permit is June 29, 1949

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 15, 1950 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1951 Extended to Oct. 1, 1953

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1952 Extended to Oct. 1, 1953
